### DMZ CABERNET ROSÉ 100% CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- Trellised vineyards located in cooler areas of the Western Cape are selected for their ability to produce fresh, fruit forward wines
- Vertical shoot positioning ensures optimum bunch exposure, resulting in fruit that can be picked early yet possess good development of varietal character
- Aromas and juicy flavors of pomegranate, watermelon and strawberries, accented with delicate floral and spice hints

### KANONKOP KADETTE PINOTAGE ROSÉ 100% PINOTAGE

- Dry farmed bush vines achieve maximum sun exposure and optimal ripeness
- Kanonkop's Pinotage vines were some of the first to be established commercially in the Cape, with some ranging up to 60 years old
- Traditional Pinotage floral aromas, flavors of raspberry and cherry emerge on a juicy, fresh palate that leads to a long, satisfying finish

### LE ROI DES PIERRES SANCERRE ROSÉ 100% PINOT NOIR

- Le Roi des Pierres, meaning "King of Stones," pays homage both to the Loire Valley's decorated royal past and its unique terroir.
- Stems from chalky, clay soils, a combination of terres blanches and caillottes terroir.
- Concentrated notes of red berries, yellow peach and plum lead to an exquisitely balanced palate of red fruits with a very elegant thread of minerality on the finish.

### MAS JANEIL LES HAUTS DE JANEIL SYRAH ROSÉ 100% SYRAH

- Grapes derive from the 59 acre estate of Mas Janeil in Maury in the Languedoc and are combined with those from neighboring vineyards closer to the coast to complement the estate fruit.
- Vines average 30 years of age and are planted in soils of eroded sandstone, schist and stony plateau that experience a Mediterranean climate— mild winters and hot, dry summers.
- Intense aromas of redcurrants, white flower and lemon entice, while red fruit dominates the refreshing palate, which is highlighted by grapefruit and a pleasing acidity.
